Do you really need to apply for more credit cards to make this work?!




There are a few work-arounds:


- Travel:

- Other non-spending ways
 - Contests (the famous pudding cups)

The thing about credit cards as a freelancer....

- You need to have a separate business card
- It should not affect your personal credit
 - Plus your credit actually goes up with more cards (crazy I know)
 - Total accounts
 - Total available spend
